Overview

Introduction, compatibility, and system overview

The XProtect AccessAXIS A1001 Network Door Controller Plug-in lets you integrate the AXIS Entry Manager with XProtect Smart Client and XProtect Mobile client. After integration, you can use XProtect Smart Client and XProtect Mobile client to:

- View events
- View status and cardholder information
- Lock and unlock doors

After integration, you can use:

- Live monitoring of access control events
- Operator-aided passage for access requests
- Map integration (only in XProtect Smart Client)
- Alarm definitions for access control events (only in XProtect Smart Client)
- Investigation of access control events
- Centralized door state overview and control
- Cardholder information

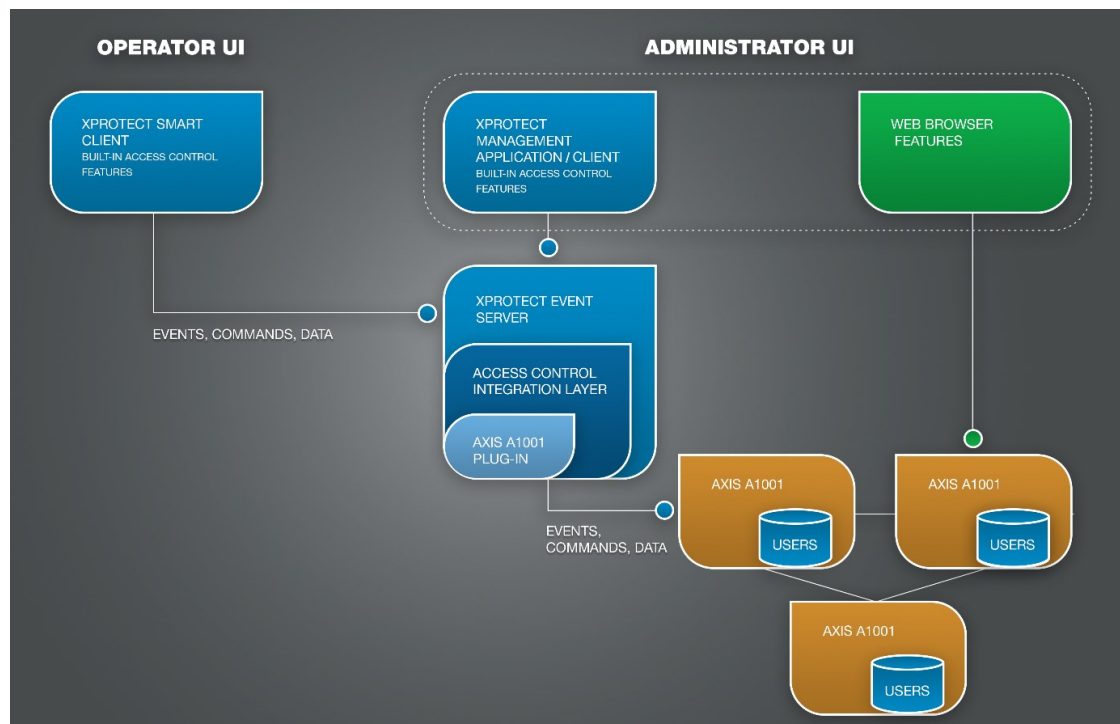

1.45 or older	2016 (10.0a)

System overview

The AXIS A1001 plug-in is an XProtect Event Server plug-in for the XProtect VMS, and it handles communication with an AXIS A1001 access control system based on the AXIS Entry Manager.

Configuration of the access control system is done via the web-based software on the AXIS A1001, while the Management Client or Management Application handles configuration of the integration with the XProtect VMS.

Finding license information (explained)

For XProtect Access, find license information in the:

- MIP Plug-ins section of Management Application
- License overview page of Management Client

For individual doors, find license information on the **Door and Associated Cameras** tab of the Access Control system integration properties.

Trial license

For XProtect Express+, XProtect Professional+, XProtect Corporate, and XProtect Expert products, XProtect Access offers a 30-day trial license for all newly added doors.

For XProtect Professional and XProtect Express products, XProtect Access offers a 30-day trial license for up to three doors.

Unlicensed doors

Unlicensed doors stay in your system, but you:

- Will not see events and status from unlicensed doors
- Cannot lock, unlock, or perform other commands on unlicensed doors

Installation

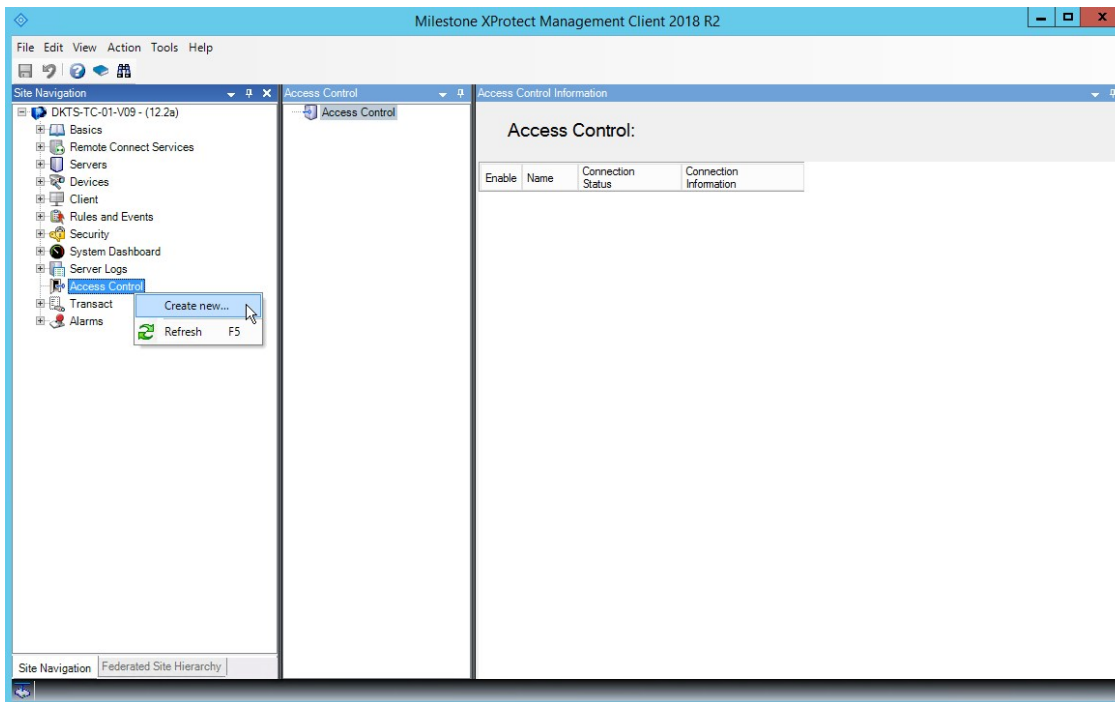
Install the AXIS A1001 plug-in

On the computer that hosts your XProtect Event Server:

1. Run MilestoneXProtectAccessAXISA1001NetworkDoorControllerPluginInstaller.exe.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the AXIS A1001 plug-in.
3. Restart your XProtect Event Server.

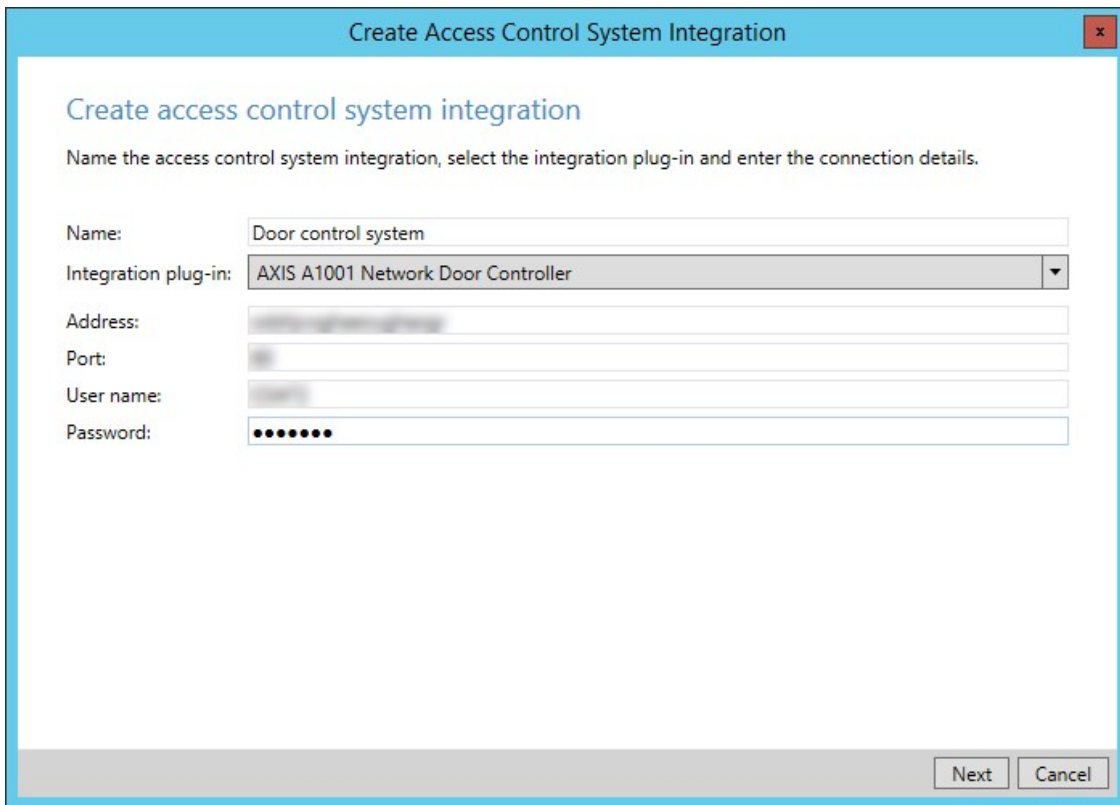
Configuration

Integrate the AXIS A1001 system with your Management Client or Management Application



In your Management Client or Management Application:

1. Right-click **Access Control**.
2. Select **Create new** to create a new integration. A dialog box appears.



Create Access Control System Integration

Create access control system integration

Name the access control system integration, select the integration plug-in and enter the connection details.

In the **Create access control system integration** dialog box:

1. In the **Name** field, enter a name for your access control system.
2. In the **Integration plug-in** field, select **AXIS A1001 Network Door Controller**.
3. In the **Address** field, enter the network address of your AXIS A1001 system.



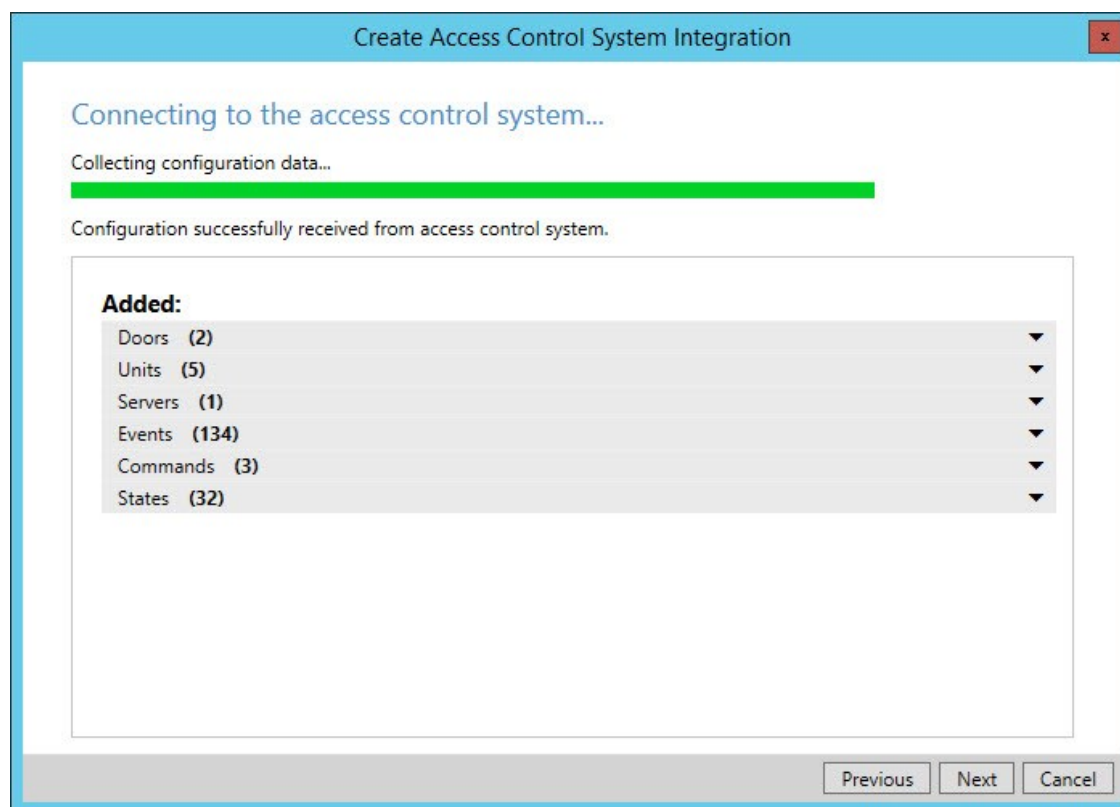
If your system is connected to more than one AXIS A1001 system, select one connection to represent your whole system.

4. In the **Port** field, enter the network port for your AXIS A1001 system.
5. In the **User name** and **Password** fields, enter your login information.

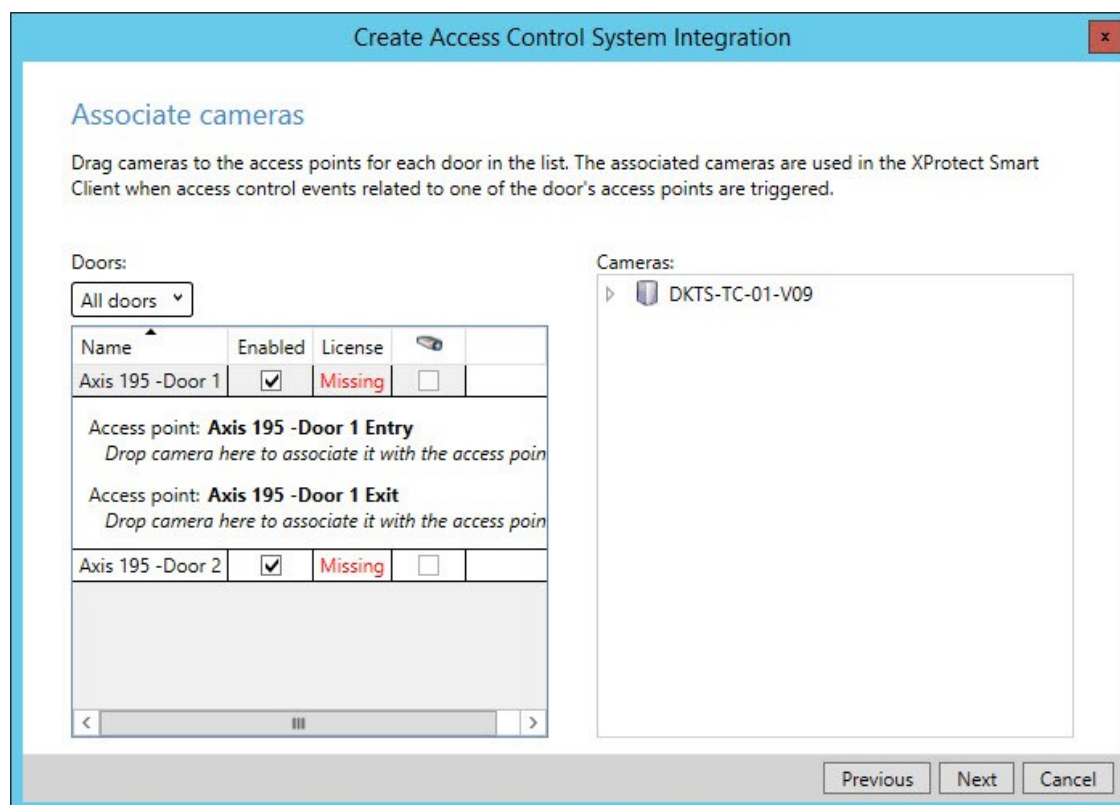


In a system with multiple connected AXIS A1001 systems, the same user name and password will be used for all controllers in the system.

6. Select **Next**.



In the **Connecting to the access control system** dialog box, your XProtect Event Server collects doors and other entities. Select **Next**.



In the **Associate cameras** dialog box:

1. In the **Cameras** pane, select a camera and drag it to an access point in the **Doors** pane.



This step is optional. You can make and change camera associations later.

2. Select **Next** to complete the integration.

The AXIS A1001 plug-in is now integrated with your XProtect Event Server, and the XProtect Access functionality is enabled in the XProtect VMS system.



Configure doors, users, access rights, and schedules via the AXIS Entry Manager by using the built-in AXIS A1001 software. For more information, see the AXIS Communications website (https://www.axis.com/access_control/).

Advanced configuration



"What are some examples of advanced tasks that I can perform with the AXIS A1001 plug-in?"

You can:

- Select and categorize events retrieved from the access control system
- Remap cameras to access points
- Configure actions associated with access control system events

Update configuration



I've added a new door, and I've also removed and renamed other doors. What do I do next?"

After you make changes to your access control system, you need to update the configuration of your integration.

In your Management Client or Management Application:

1. Select **Access Control**.
2. Your access control integrations appear as nodes below **Access Control**. Select the integration that you want to update.
3. On the **General Settings** tab, click **Refresh Configuration**. Your XProtect Event Server plug-in collects added, changed, and removed items from your access control system.
4. Select **Apply** to update the configuration of your integration.

Maintenance

Uninstall the AXIS A1001 plug-in

On the computer that hosts your XProtect Event Server:

1. In Management Client or Management Application, delete all AXIS A1001 plug-in integrations.
2. In Windows 10:
 1. Select the **Start menu**.
 2. Select **Settings**.
 3. Select **Apps**. You will see a list of all installed apps.
 4. Find and select **XProtect AccessAXIS A1001 Network Door Controller Plug-in**.
 5. Select **Uninstall**.
 6. Follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the AXIS A1001 plug-in.
